

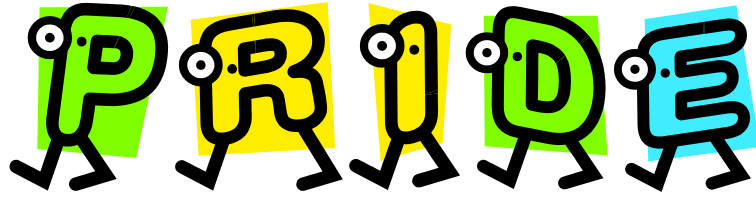

How does Montclair rate as a PBIS school?

Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) is a data-driven school-wide initiative for improving social competence and academic achievement for all students. The North Carolina Department of Public Instruction (NCDPI) recognizes schools across the state each year for high implementation success of PBIS by awarding three levels of recognition; Green Ribbon, Model, and Exemplar. Montclair was recently named a NC PBIS Model School. The school received a 96% SET (School-wide Evaluation Tool) score after a PBIS walkthrough by District Coach, Tony Lawrence, on March 27. This is exciting news, as last year's score was 78%. Our goal for next year is 100%!
